- Will continue to be a well respected strong voice for our area.

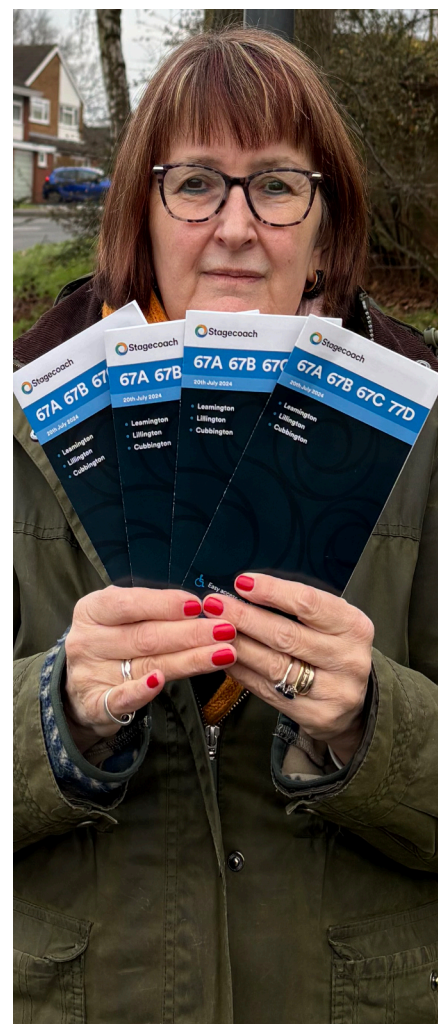
Sarah has lived in Lillington since 1987, and her children attended local schools. She is a governor at Telford Infant School and is the Treasurer of the Lillington Funday.

Kelvin Road Pedestrian Safety Improvements



Work has recently been completed to improve safety for pedestrians at the Kelvin Road / Beaufort Avenue junction by adding bollards and safety barriers.

‘This scheme was paid for out of my highways budget

following advice from the police that action was required.

The work includes painting ‘H’ markings across more driveways in Kelvin Road and Beaufort Avenue to discourage parking which blocks access, making it easier for residents to access their drives’ commented Cllr Sarah Boad.

Taylor Avenue Dropped Kerbs will be installed shortly

Dropped kerbs will be installed in Gresham Avenue at the two Taylor Avenue junctions in the next couple of weeks.

Cllr Sarah Boad commented ‘This work is being paid for out of my highways budget – and will provide a much better route for those using wheelchairs, scooters and pushchairs.’
